May 10, 2012

- Arrival in Seoul

May 11, 2012

- AM Visit to KPL/KWPA² headquarters for introduction to South Korea's peasant movements
- PM Visit to food markets in Seoul and Korean cooking class

May 12, 2012

- AM – Leave Seoul
- PM Visit Jongeup, site of the 1894 Donghak Peasant Revolution

- Arrive at Gwangju Hotel

May 13

- AM Visit May 18th Memorial Park and meet with survivors of the 1980 Gwangju Massacre

- PM Depart for Jeju Island
- Arrive in Jeju and Hotel Check-in

May 14

- AM Introduction to Jeju by KPL/KWPA representatives
- PM Visit to Women's Native Seed Cooperative
- Dinner at Buddhist restaurant in Jeju

May 15

- AM Visit to Jeju Peace Memorial Museum. Between 1948-1950, 75% of all villages and 10% of the local population were killed by paramilitary groups supported by the US army. (<http://www.peacemuseum.co.kr/>)
- PM Visit to Gangjeong Village, site of struggle between local farmers and the South Korean navy seeking to build a new strategic naval base in collaboration with the US. (http://www.savejejuisland.org/Save_Jeju_Island/Welcome.html)
- Free evening in Jeju

May 16

- AM visit to Jeju Tangerine Farm. Meet some of the farmers whose livelihoods are threatened by the Korea - US Free Trade Agreement (KORUS FTA).
- PM Depart for Busan
- Arrive at hotel near Busan

May 17

- AM visit to Hanam. Site of land struggle between local farmers being displaced by the government's Four Rivers Project.
- PM Depart for Sangju
- Arrival and check in at Sangju hotel

May 18

- AM/PM Visit to Sangju Women's Community Supported Agriculture cooperative
- PM Departure for Chuncheon
- Arrival and check-in at Chuncheon hotel

May 19

- AM Visit Chuncheon beef cooperative. 40 small farm families have joined together to raise and sell their beef locally in Chuncheon.
- PM Free afternoon in Chuncheon
- Dinner at Cooperative restaurant
- Return to Seoul

May 20

- Departure from Seoul
